Scholarship Background

Eligibility Criteria

- Candidates must be a graduating high school senior from central Ohio (Franklin and contiguous counties), OH; or Pittsburgh, PA and surrounding counties.
 - Ohio Counties: Delaware County, Fairfield County, Franklin County, Licking County, Madison County, Pickaway County, Union County
 - Pennsylvania Counties: Allegheny County, Beaver County, Butler County, Washington County, Westmoreland County
- Candidates must have a grade point average between 2.5 and 3.5.
- Candidates must enroll in a two- or four-year, post-secondary educational institution or an accredited trade or apprenticeship program.
- Candidates must plan to major in a construction industry field (e.g. construction management, architecture, engineering, HVAC, etc.).
- Candidates must attend or plan to attend an educational institution in the U.S.

Selection Criteria

- 50% Financial Need
- 30% Hard Work (extracurricular, work, volunteer, sports)
- 20% Character (essay, letters of recommendation, demonstrated perseverance)

Selection Committee

- Representative, CBC
- Representative, Financial Aid
- Community Representative

Award Amount

One \$8,000 payable over four years for a student in a four-year program One \$2,000 payable over two years for a student in a two-year program

Renewal

Scholarship is renewable, provided the recipient maintains a minimum 2.5 grade point average.

Payment Distribution All awards are paid directly to the educational institution.

The scholarship funds may be used for tuition, room and board, and books. This scholarship award is NOT TO DISPLACE any institutional or other aid.

March 1, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. EST

Application and Award Process

- The Columbus Foundation sends notification of the scholarship's availability each spring to eligible schools.
- Candidates complete the online application by the deadline.
- After the deadline, The Columbus Foundation reviews complete applications for eligibility.
- The Foundation sets up the selection committee meeting.
- After the meeting, the Foundation sends award letters to recipients that explain the payment request process and include the proof of enrollment form and notifies those who did not receive the scholarship.
- Once proof of enrollment has been received by the Foundation, a check will be sent to the recipient's educational institution.
