The PAHRA Board of Directors is proud to announce its Thirty-Third Annual Scholarship Program to benefit those individuals who reside in low-income housing or a redevelopment area who wish to continue their education. The purpose of the scholarship program is to encourage higher education, develop self-sufficiency and increase self-esteem among these residents.

Under the L. DeWitt Boosel High School student/graduate category, the following will be awarded:

1st place \$3,000
 2nd place \$2,000
 3rd place \$1,000

Under the Paul G. Pecharko Adult resident attending a post-secondary institution category, the following will be awarded:

1st place \$3,000
 2nd place \$2,000
 3rd place \$1,000

Each PAHRA member is encouraged to participate in the scholarship process. Carefully read the enclosed material outlining the scholarship requirements.

The Application from the individual must be post-marked by Monday, March 15, 2021, to the Agency, therefore permitting each Agency time to review and certify the application before submitting one application from the high school senior/graduate and one application from an adult resident to the scholarship committee by Monday, April 19, 2021.

Please remember that the selected application must be submitted by the Agency, <u>not</u> the applicant. Should the committee receive an application directly from the applicant, it will be disqualified immediately and not considered for award.

It is our hope that each of you will do as much as you can to promote this year's program.



The Pennsylvania Association of Housing & Redevelopment Agencies (PAHRA) is making available a total of \$12,000 annually in scholarship monies to encourage higher education, develop self-sufficiency, and increase self-esteem for:

- residents of a federally-subsidized public housing (PH) community or RAD conversion under ownership / management of a public housing authority (LIHTC or other affordable housing is not eligible)
- participants in the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) program
- persons residing in an area directly served by a PAHRA member city or county redevelopment authority

Scholarships are offered in one of two categories as follows:

- L. DeWitt Boosel Memorial Scholarship eligible applicant must be a high school senior OR age 20 or younger, who is not
 currently or has not previously been enrolled in an institution of higher learning or other accredited type of post-secondary
 education
- Paul G. Pecharko Memorial Scholarship eligible applicant must be age 21 or older OR a student between the ages of 18-20, who is currently enrolled in an institution of higher learning or other accredited type of post-secondary education

Additional requirements to determine scholarship eligibility are listed below.

- 1) Applicant must be a PAHRA member agency's PH or RAD conversion resident, HCV participant, or resident of an area served directly by a redevelopment authority for at least 12 months immediately preceding the date that scholarship applications are due to PAHRA.
- 2) Eligible applicants must be pursuing post-secondary education in an accredited vocational/technical course, trade school certification, college, university, online or distance learning degree program. Graduate programs are eligible.
- 3) With the exception of online or distance learning institutions, the school must be located within the state of Pennsylvania. Applicants must be considered to be registered on a full-time basis.
- 4) Annual income of the applicant's family must fall within the current Section 8 low-income guidelines as certified by the local agency. Please note that scholarships are considered income, so they are taxable.
 - 5) Applicants who have received a scholarship through PAHRA during the prior year are not eligible to apply.
- 6) A list of schools to which the applicant has applied / been accepted must be provided. Scholarship award is subject to proof of acceptance and confirmation of enrollment to the school of the applicant's choice.
- 7) Scholarship award will be paid in two installments: 50% in June/July upon award notification; the remaining 50% in January of the following year. Payment is conditional upon proof of continued enrollment or completion of courses. Sponsoring agency is responsible to provide PAHRA with proof of continued enrollment or completion of courses.
- 8) L. DeWitt Boosel Memorial Scholarship applicants must have maintained a 2.5 grade point average (C+) or higher during their entire high school years. GPA must be certified by the high school through the latest marking period along with high school transcripts.
- 9) Paul G. Pecharko Memorial Scholarship applicants must provide a copy of their high school diploma or equivalent. In addition, any applicant already enrolled in an accredited program must verify their current or most recent GPA.
- 10) All required materials as outlined on the Scholarship Application must be submitted with the application and shall become the property of the PAHRA Scholarship Committee. It is important to note that if any required materials are missing from the application package, the application will be eliminated from consideration.

All applications must be submitted through and recommended by a PAHRA member agency. Each member agency may submit only one application in each category.

The agency is responsible for verifying all application requirements and collecting all application materials, as well as local promotion of the scholarship program within their jurisdiction.

Applications must be submitted to the PAHRA member agency by Monday, March 15, 2021.

The PAHRA member agency must submit the application/s to PAHRA by Monday, April 19, 2021.
