Demigod's Quest Camp (age 7 to 13)*

Robotics (ages 8 to 10)

Campers will be introduced to the VEX Robotics System. Campers will create builds using the VEX IQ Super Kit and learn how to have their builds perform various tasks using the new VEXcode programming language. Campers will collaborate to solve various challenges and compete in camp competitions with their builds.
