Vietnam Veterans of America, Chapter 862 is pleased to announce that three (3) \$1000.00 scholarships will be awarded to Beaver County or other Pennsylvania counties high school graduating seniors or out of state graduating seniors related to a member of Vietnam Veterans of America, Chapter 862 who meet the following criteria:

- 1. The student is a graduating senior, who is a child, grandchild, stepchild, or legally adopted child of a Vietnam era veteran, KIA, MIA, or deceased Vietnam era veteran. A copy of Veteran's discharge papers (DD-214) are to be submitted with the scholarship application.
- 2. The student has achieved a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0. The applicant will submit a notarized copy of his/her high school transcripts verifying that this requirement has been met.
- 3. The student will submit a Beaver County Vietnam Veterans Scholarship application plus all required paperwork by April 15 of his/her senior year. Any applications received after April 15 will be declared ineligible.
- 4. The student must submit two letters of recommendation: One from a teacher, the other from a school administrator.
- 5. The student must submit a statement explaining why he/she should receive this scholarship.
- 6. The student must submit a copy of an acceptance letter from an accredited four-year, two-year, and/or technical school. The letter to be received by the April 15 deadline.
- 7. The student will submit a five hundred (500) word essay on the topic PROUD TO BE AN AMERICAN AND ITS RESPONSIBLITIES. The essay will be typed, doubled-spaced, with a title page that includes students name, high school, date, and title of essay.
