AP EXAM ADMINSTRATION: Ambridge Area High School

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Please note the following important communication regarding the upcoming Advanced Placement Exam Administration:

- See below for a full exam schedule including all dates and times of each exam.
- All exams will be paper and pencil and must be taken in-person.
- Attendance: Students testing will be required to be in attendance for their exam only and will be marked present for the day. (For example, if your student has an 8:00am exam, they are permitted to leave with a parent note at the conclusion of their exam. If a student has a 12:00pm exam, they are permitted to come in only for their exam at noon. Students coming in late or leaving early will be responsible for their own transportation.)
- Exams beginning at 12:00pm may conclude after 2:30pm and students will then be responsible for their own transportation home.
- Testing will be held in the LGI. Students should wait for an announcement for their exam. **Students who arrive late to their exam will NOT be permitted to test.**
- Exam fees have been paid for by Ambridge Area School District for the 2021-2022 school year.

The College Board reminds students that they should bring the following items on test day:

- No. 2 pencils (non-mechanical)
- Pens with black or blue ink
- Approved calculators (for a full list of approved calculators, please see www. apstudents.org/calculators)

The College Board reminds students that electronic devices including phones, smart watches, fitness trackers, wearable technology, cameras, ear buds, etc. are prohibited on test day.
