## WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Courses are released to staff and students
- Teachers meet with students to discuss recommendations for next school year and submit individual recommendation for each student in core courses Math, English, Science, Social Studies, Language
- Three (3) week window opens, students log-on to their Student Tyler account via the Computer to submit recommended courses and electives. All selections by students are due by 2/08/23
- This must be done through the STUDENTS TYLER ACCOUNT not Parent Portal
- Window closes; Parents will receive course selections in mail, sign off and return to guidance. There will
  be one week window to contact your students counselor with any changes.
- All requested parent changes must be submitted by 2/15/23. If a parent overrides a teacher recommendation, a course waiver sheet is required to be completed.

## WHAT TO EXPECT?

- STUDENTS TYLER ACCOUNT All students are to log-in using their own student
  Tyler account information via the Computer. Access through a cell phone does not always
  translate correctly.
- Please be sure you are familiar with your student username and password for Tyler.






TYLER 360 (Left-Hand Side)








# STEPTWO: ADDING CHOSEN ELECTIVES FOR THE 2023-2024 SCHOOLYEAR

#### ADDING ELECTIVES: CLICK ON GRADE ELECTIVES ON TOP LEFT CORNER:

PLEASE SELECT A MINIMUM OF 5.00 TO A MAXIMUM OF 7.00 ELECTIVE CREDITS IN ORDER OF PREFERENCE.
ALL SCHEDULES MUST CONTAIN 8.00 TO 9.00 CREDITS TOTAL. FOR ANY .5 CREDIT CLASSES, 2 HALF CREDIT ELECTIVES MUST BE SELECTED TO EQUAL 1.00 FULL CREDIT.


FOR EXAMPLE: SELECT ART I (.5 CREDIT) AND ART II (.5 CREDIT) = 1.00 CREDIT PLEASE NOTE: PLEASE REFER TO THE COURSE SELECTION BOOK FOR ANY PRE-REQUISITES FOR A CLASS. IF YOU DO NOT MEET THE CLASS PRE-REQUISITES, YOU MAY BE REMOVED FROM THAT ELECTIVE CHOICE. FOR EXAMPLE, SELECT ART II, YOU MUST BE SURE YOU HAVE TAKEN ART I BEFORE SELECTING ART II




#### YOU WILL THEN CLICK ON GRADE ELECTIVES:

A DROP DOWN SPACE WILL APPEAR TO ADD IN ELECTIVES. ALL ELECTIVES AS PER YOUR GRADE LEVEL WILL BE AVAILABLE TO SELECT.

PLEASE SELECT A MINIMUM OF 5.00 TO A MAXIMUM OF 7.00 ELECTIVE CREDITS. IF ADDITIONAL SPACES ARE NEEDED, PLEASE CLICK ON THE SIGN ON THE UPPER CORNER TO ADD MORE ELECTIVES AND SELECTION SPACES AS NEEDED. YOU MAY ADD MORE THAN 6.00 ELECTIVES FOR ADDITIONAL ALTERNATIVES.



# ONCE COMPLETED WITH ELECTIVES, HIT **SAVE** ON THE LOWER RIGHT HAND CORNER OF YOUR SCREEN. STUDENTS CAN CHANGE SELECTIONS UP UNTIL 2/08/23, THEN SCHEDULING WILL BE CLOSED.



# ADDING ELECTIVES – CLASSES YOU CHOOSE FOR NEXT YEAR


- Please select a minimum of 5.00 to a maximum of 7.00 Elective credits. List electives in order of preference. You may select more than 7.00 electives for more alternatives.
- All Schedules must contain 8.00 to 9.00 Total credits.
- For any .5 credit classes, 2 half credit electives must be selected to equal 1.00 full credit. For example: Select Art I (.5 Credit) and Art II (.5 Credit) = 1.00 Credit
- Please Note: Please refer to the Course Selection Book for any Pre-Requisites for a class. If you do not
  meet the class Pre-Requisites, you may be removed from that elective choice. For example, select Art II,
  you must be sure you have taken Art I AND passed Art I before selecting Art II.
- Any student that has not passed the Pre-Requisite course will be removed from the next course progression. Example: Remove Art II if did not Pass Art I
- Any course currently scheduled for second semester: Electives will be removed in reflection of end of year grade if not passed


# COURSE REQUEST SCREEN –TEACHER RECOMMENDED COURSES CLICK ON SCHOOL ENTERED

## THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- Please select a minimum of 5.00 to a maximum of 7.00 Elective credits. All Schedules must contain 8.00 to 9.00 TOTAL credits. Can contain more. For any .5 credit classes, 2 half credit electives must be selected to equal 1.00 full credit. For example: Select Art I (.5 Credit) and Art II (.5 Credit) = 1.00 Credit
- Please refer to the Course Selection Book for any Pre-Requisites for a class. If you do not meet the class Pre-Requisites, you may be removed from that elective choice. For example, select Art II, you must be sure you have taken Art I and PASS the class before selecting Art II If the course has a pre-requisite there will be an (\*) next to it.
- Important: If you plan on taking a certain elective you must meet the prerequisite. If not meeting requirements, students may be removed and have the possibility of being placed into a course that you may have not selected.
- All second semester electives will be adjusted to reflect the grade earned and ability to meet prerequisite.
