- 2. Must have achieved a 3.5 GPA
- 3. Must enroll in an eligible college or university the first semester following graduation
- 4. Must maintain a 4 year or less graduation schedule
- 5. Must work 240 hours prior to commencement of the fall semester in college
- Applicant's gross household income reported for 2021 Federal Income Tax Purposes must not have exceeded \$85,000.
