I hope this letter finds you well. My name is Vanessa McCarthy-Johnson, and I am reaching out to share information about an exciting scholarship opportunity available for your students. I am delighted to announce the **Olympus Energy STEM Scholarship** for the academic year 2024-2025. This scholarship is designed to support students pursuing degrees in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math-related (STEM-related) fields. The scholarship is open now and closes on **January 8, 2024 at 3:00 pm Central Time**. Students can go to <https://learnmore.scholarsapply.org/olympusenergy/> to learn more about the scholarship and to apply.

Applicants for this scholarship must self-identify as Black or African American, American Indian, or Alaska Native, Hispanic or Latino, Asian, Native Hawaiian, or other Pacific Islander and reside in one of the counties in the Greater Pittsburgh region (Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Butler, Fayette, Greene, Indiana, Washington, and Westmoreland). The students should be planning to pursue a degree or certification in a STEM-related program of study and enroll part-time or full-time in an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year. The student should also have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or its equivalent and never been convicted of a misdemeanor or felony crime.

The selection committee will look at academic performance, demonstrated leadership, work experience and a personal statement that will give details on the student's career and educational goals and objectives. Unusual family or personal circumstances also will be considered, while financial need will not be factored into the decision. Preference will be given to those students who will be pursuing energy-related STEM majors.

There will be up to four (4) awards of \$2,500 each year. The Awards are renewable for up to three (3) additional years or until a bachelor's degree is earned, whichever occurs first. Recipients may be considered for future internship and/or employment opportunities with Olympus Energy.

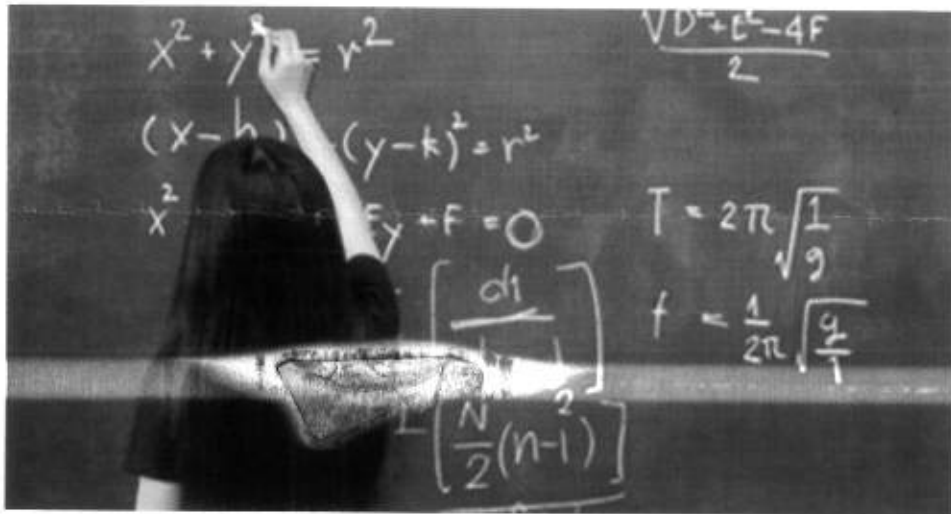

Part-time or full-time undergraduate studying at an accredited two- or four-year university or vocational-technical school

Enrolled at an accredited two- or four-year university or technical school

Reside in one of these Southwestern Pennsylvania counties

Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Butler, Fayette, Greene, Indiana, Washington, Westmoreland.
