## **PUSH Beaver County Scholarship Program 2024 Requirements**

PUSH Beaver County is offering four \$1,000 Academic Scholarships to graduating seniors and one \$1,000 Academic Scholarship to graduating senior in the JROTC program. Students must meet the following criteria:

1. Applicant must be attending, and in good standing, either a public, private or cyber school within Beaver County, Pennsylvania.
2. Applicant must be a resident of Beaver County, Pennsylvania for four (4) or more years and be a citizen of the United States or a lawful permanent resident.
3. Applicant must be registered or have a written commitment to attend a higher education institution within Beaver County (Exception for RMU (Robert Morris University), and trade schools located in Butler, Lawrence, & Allegheny County). This includes but is not limited to universities, community college, trade schools, technical schools, and beauty academies.
4. Applicant must have a cumulative high school grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
